BIDDING PROCEDURES. The contractor shall submit a total price for the complete stage lighting replacement as specified.

This project does not require prevailing wages for the successful contractor's workers.

The contractor shall submit the maximum number of calendar days it will need to complete this project in sealed bid documentation as well as projected calendar of work days. It is the desire of Richmond Community Schools to complete this project during the time period from **December 1, 2018** and January **31, 2019**. The contractor shall indicate if it is able to complete this project within this time period, and if not, indicate its alternative starting and ending project dates. Failure to complete this project by the successful contractor's stated ending date shall subject the success contractor to liquidated damages of \$100 per calendar day for this delay.

Richmond Community Schools reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids and to waive any irregularities in the process, which, in the opinion of Richmond Community Schools, will result in producing the best interest to Richmond Community Schools.
