RFP Clarifications:

- Instead of the 5% Bid Bond included on page 7 of the RFP, Bidders shall provide performance and payment bonds in accordance with, and as required by, MCL 129.201, et seq., in an amount equal to 100% of the contract sum.
- 2. All proposed equipment must be permanently installed with cement footings by Professional Playground Installers and according to Code.
- 3. Pea stone in Middle School playground area will be removed by District as needed for installation of proposed new equipment.
- 4. The depth of the pea stone on the Middle School playground is estimated to be 10-12 inches.
- Bidders should include in their proposals separate costs, outside of the \$25,500 and \$60,000 allocated for playground equipment, for the following:
 - a. cost of non-woven geo textile fabric and cost of installation
 - b. cost of edging/perimeter wall and cost of installation
- 6. Height of current swing set at Middle School to be changed only if needed to meet Code.
- 7. Color options should include colors similar to current equipment on Will L. Lee Elementary School playground.
- Certificate of Liability Insurance will need to be provided upon award of bid listing Richmond Community Schools as additional insured and with a minimum of \$1,000,000 in liability insurance coverage.
- 9. There is no old playground equipment to be removed.
- 10. There is an asphalt area for basketball hoops along the edge of the current asphalt between the Middle School and the playground.
- 11. District's dumpsters are available after school is out for the summer. The last day of school is currently expected to be Monday, June 10.
