Goal: The Superintendent, in partnership with the Executive Director of Curriculum & Educational Services and building/departments administrators, shall develop and implement a plan for a comprehensive scope and sequence curriculum that includes Power Standards in the areas of mathematics and science to focus on improving instructional outcomes in the classroom, and a plan to add Language Arts, Social Studies, and non-core subjects in the near future.

COMPONENT 4: COMMUNICATION AND COMMUNITY RELATIONS.

Goal: The Superintendent shall publish a district newsletter which shall be mailed to all households in the zip codes serviced by Richmond Community Schools. Target dates include March/April, June, and September.
