Web:

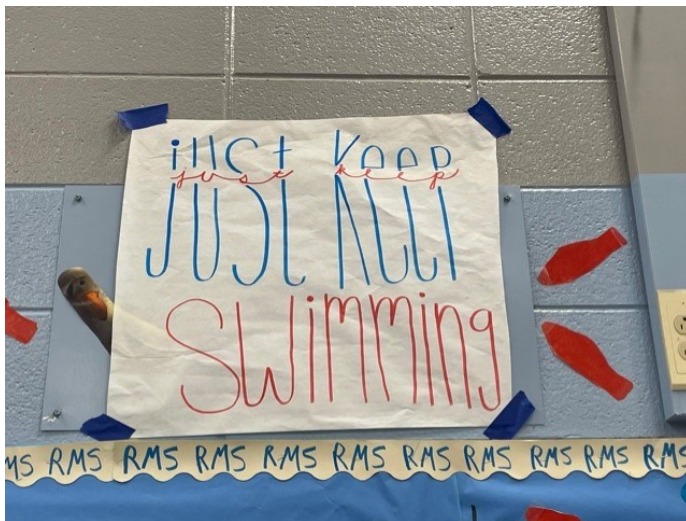

Green Team:

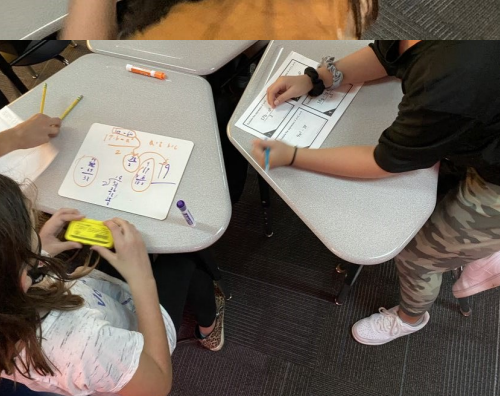
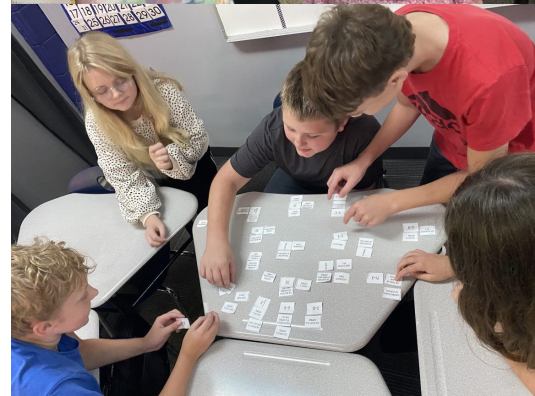

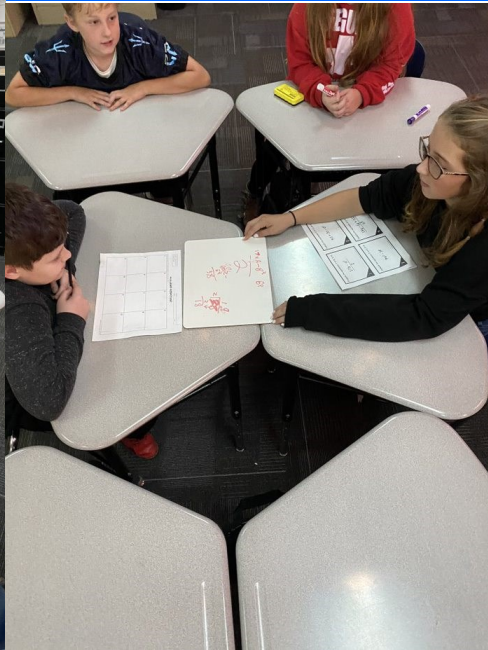
