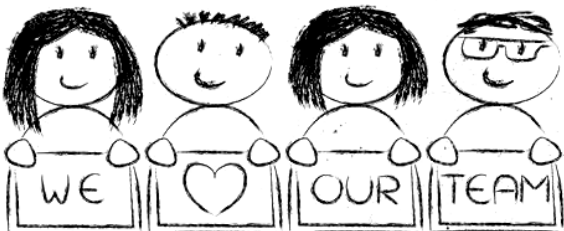
A Message from Mr. Gibson

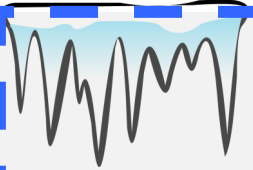

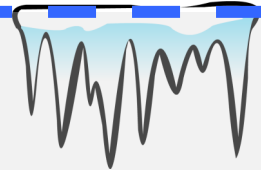
